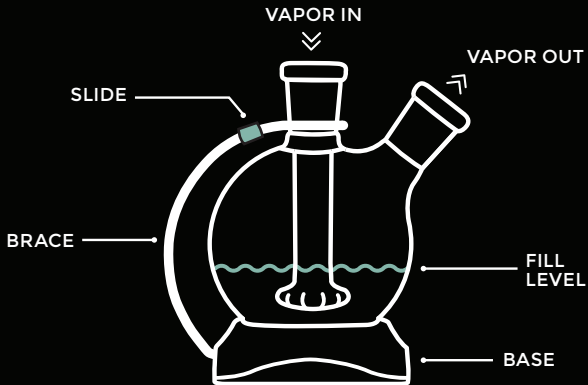

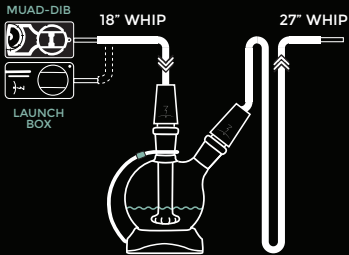
LAUNCH BOX SAFETY



When using the Launch Box with the Orbiter, it may be difficult to accurately sense the temperature of the vapor.

For this reason, we recommend use only for Advanced Users already familiar with the way that the Launch Box heating works in order to avoid combusting your trench.

CONNECTING THE WHIPS



Two Water Pipe Whips are included with your Orbiter. Connect the 18" Whip to your vaporizer and use the 27" Whip to draw your vapor.

REMOVING THE GLASS

ALWAYS REMOVE GLASS FROM BASE WHEN
ADDING/REMOVING WATER TO AVOID DAMAGING WOOD

Pull back the **SLIDE** on the
BRACE to release tension.

2



Remove the **GLASS** from
the **BRACE** and **BASE**.

FILLING IT UP

**ALWAYS REMOVE GLASS FROM BASE WHEN
ADDING/REMOVING WATER TO AVOID DAMAGING WOOD**

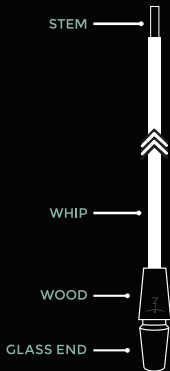
- 1** Remove **GLASS** from **BRACE** and **BASE**.
- 2** Add water to the **FILL LEVEL**.
- 3** Return **GLASS** to the **BASE** and **BRACE**.
- 4** With **GLASS** in the **BRACE**, return the **SLIDE** to the top of the **BRACE** to lock in place.

CLEANING GLASS

**ALWAYS REMOVE GLASS FROM BASE WHEN
ADDING/REMOVING WATER TO AVOID DAMAGING WOOD**

- 1** Remove **GLASS** from **BRACE** and **BASE** and drain the liquid.
- 2** Add small amount (20-30ml) of Isopropyl Alcohol.
- 3** Add a generous amount of salt to act as an abrasive.
- 4** Cover both openings with your fingers and shake vigorously until all residue is removed.
- 5** Rinse with water to remove all ISO and salt, then return **GLASS** to the **BASE** and **BRACE**.

CLEANING WHIPS



- 1 Remove the stem from the end of the whip.
- 2 Slide the wood portion off of the whip.
- 3 Soak in hot water for about 5 minutes to loosen buildup inside of the whip.
- 4 Hold securely from glass end and squeeze residue out of the open end like toothpaste.
- 5 Apply continuous pressure as you work your fingers along the length of the whip.
- 6 Dry whip thoroughly, then slide wood portion back onto the whip and reinsert stem.
